Mess Tin Cover

Use unbleached linen. Using the pattern provided, cut out the pieces as follows:

- Cut out two of the top/bottom pieces. If you wish to feld the seams, add ¼" to the outside of the curved edge of the pattern.
- The side piece is ½ of the pattern; double the material, with the fold at the edge of the pattern marked "fold", before cutting.
- Cut out three keeper straps; or, cut one strap 3X the length of the pattern, to be cut into thirds after sewing the strap.

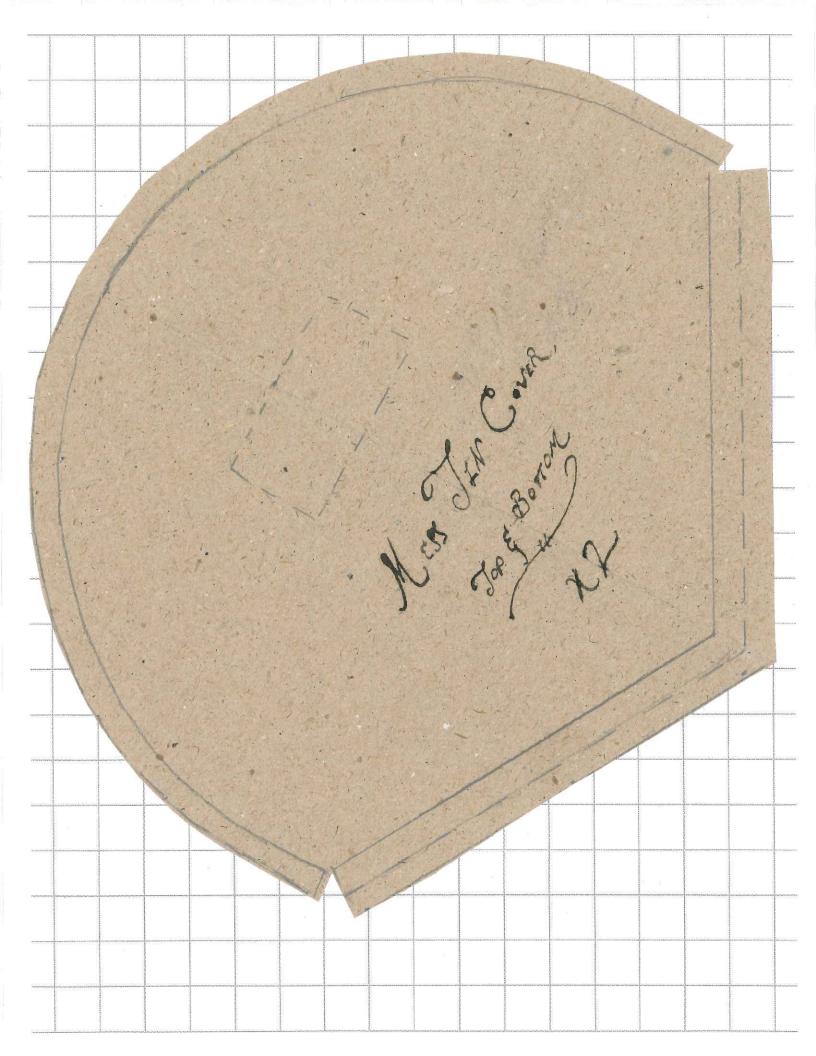
Cut two tabs out of undyed or buff leather. Punch a small hole in each tab, and cut up from the hole to create a button hole in the tab.

You will also need a strong thread for hand sewing, either linen or unbleached cotton, and two ½" bone or horn buttons.

- 1. Hem the edges of the back flaps on the top, bottom, and sides. Fold the cut edge in ½", then fold again. Pin, and hem with a whip stitch.
- 2. Fold the keeper strap lengthwise into thirds (like a letter), using the dotted lines on the pattern as a guide. Turn the upper cut edge under at the middle of the strap, and pin. Sew with a whip stitch through all layers of the strap, "short" stitch at the back seam, "long" stitch on the front side, parallel to the direction of the strap.
- 3. Fold ends of the straps under. Sew one strap to the centre of each of the top, bottom and side pieces, using a back stitch to sew 2 lines at each end of the strap.
- 4. Sew the top and bottom to the side piece, using a back stitch. Sew a running stitch half-way between the seam and the cut edge of the fabric to prevent the cut edge from fraying. (Or, feld the seam.)
- 5. Place the mess tin into the cover, and use a pencil to lightly mark where the leather tabs will be sewn to the back flaps. I find it helpful to lightly glue the leather to the fabric before sewing; acrylic glue, contact or rubber cement works. Sew one tab to one of the side flaps, and one tab to the top flap.
- 6. Place the tin into the cover again, and mark where the buttonholes fall. Sew the buttons to the bottom and side flaps opposite the tabs.
