

RIFLE DRILL MOVEMENTS CIRCA 1860
QUEEN'S OWN RANGERS

Video 1

- Marching by the flank in 4s, arms trailed (standardized at this time)
- Left turn to form line (note undoubling is automatic)
- Advance by files from the centre
- To the front, form
- Right wheel
- By the right flank (right turn)
- By the left flank (left turn), forms line

Video 2

- Left wheel
- Right turn
- Right-about, form
- Extend left & right
- Training formation for bayonet exercise
- Assemble on the centre
- Right-about, halt

Video 3

- Extend left & right
- Advance, firing (note the whistle, & how the files do not leapfrog)
- Rally on the centre; guard against cavalry
- Reform skirmish line
- Retire firing (note the use of left-about to rotate the files)

Video 4

- Assemble on the reserve
- Fire by files (note the deliberate firing, and lack of misfires due to the percussion caps)
- Fire by company
- March by; eyes right
- Left Wheel
- Right turn
